Early spring 1967	Hartman and Olds began efforts to obtain time-sharing service.
Spring 1967	Ed Greene unable to support project.
Spring 1967	Wrote proposal to inform College of need.
29 July 1967	Wrote G.E. about their t-s service.
Fall 1967	Demonstration by C-A-C.
Nov. 1967	SCFIC proposal submitted.
14 Dec. 1967	Wrote NSF for guidelines.
21 Dec. 1967	NSF reply.
8 March 1968	Inquiry from SREB.
23 March 1968	Sent draft proposal to NSF.
29 March 1968	Asked President Marsh for financial help.
8 April 1968	President Marsh approved cost-sharing agreement.
10 April 1968	Telegram from SREB re. meeting in Atlanta.
15 April	Service initiated with G.E.
19 April	Sent SREB a proposal outline for 1130 computer rental.
23 April	Meeting in Atlanta with SREB and NSF.
July 1968	SREB/NSF grant announcement received.
16 July 1968	Removed previous NSF proposal.
July 1968	Terminal Talk begun.
1 August 1968	Switched to Call-A-Computer and grant funds.
31 August 1968	Dropped G.E. service.
